The Uncompromised Word

Because we work with many different denominations, there is often the temptation to try to avoid saying or doing anything that would offend or go against the beliefs of others. Recently, Larry ministered in one of the local churches on a Wednesday night. He resolved, “I can only be who I am and present God’s Word in the way which He chooses — unashamedly, unapologetically, and uncompromisingly”.

Praise God, the ministry was received so well that the Pastor asked him if he would be willing to

minister **the same message** on the following Sunday morning and evening.

Many, many people came up after each service to tell how much the message blessed them and ministered to a situation they were dealing with at that time. One man shared that not only was the message practical and relevant but that he so enjoyed Larry’s “**style**” of teaching. He said that there was no way that he could go to sleep while Larry was ministering. Thank God that Larry’s priority was not to try to fit in.



Reaching the Unreached

Since having relocated to Recife, our opportunities to minister have been almost constant.

While working with various churches and organizations, we have aided in children's outreaches, Sunday School programs, ministry to the poor, and teaching God's Word in remote locations. All of this was in addition to numerous preaching engagements.

We are working with one church to offer a Sunday School outreach which is a blessing in that it reaches the people in our community with the Word of God in an enjoyable format. The breakfast that is offered will be the only real meal that some of the people will have on that day. It is not unusual for them to come back for seconds and even thirds of the various fruits and sandwiches. Several of the people walk as many as 3 miles to attend.

One of my most enjoyable experiences was a trip that we made to the remote "city" of Japaratinga, Alagoas (a two hour drive). It was such a blessing to minister to the

people in this small community. The simplicity of their lifestyle is awesome. A couple of years ago, there was only one Christian there. As a result of much prayer, the gospel is now being brought to his people on a consistent basis. It has only been a few months since they have gotten electricity in their area. They give all the honor to God and recognize that He is the one who is prospering them.

Another one of my favorite occasions has been ministering during a weekly worship service which a local businessman hosts. It boasts of attendees from many different churches and denominations. It is beautiful to watch the group come together and allow the Spirit to flow as all worship together in unity.

On one particular Saturday night, Larry and I participated in a water baptism ceremony on the beach. All of the 48 people getting baptized were dressed in flowing white robes. It was so awesome to see the group plunged one by one beneath the crashing waves.

The hunt continues for office space to house Living Water Teaching — Brazil. Once again, we are attempting to secure a location which has adequate space for offices,

classes, as well as our living area.

We currently have a temporary housing situation which is serving us until we acquire something better. Though there are several negative things about the house, there is only one which I will mention: Our neighborhood has a reputation of being very dangerous. Praise God we have ministering angels to watch over us

and to protect us!

On a positive note: the house we are in is inexpensive and we have it on a month to month basis without a contract thus allowing us the flexibility to move as soon as we find our new place!

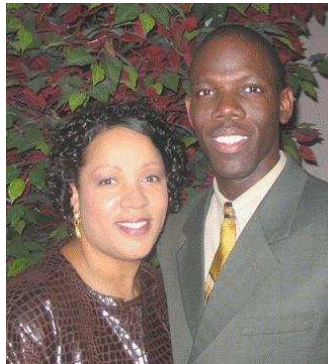
